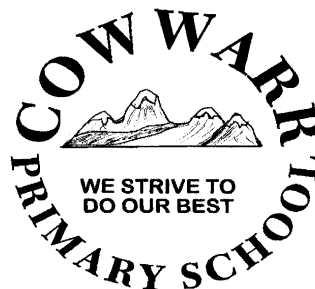
Toongabbie Tennis Club Registration Day **THIS SUNDAY Sept 13th.**
